- *St. Thomas District — Friday, August 28, 2026, 6:00 p.m. – 8:30 p.m., Charlotte Amalie High School*
- *St. Croix District — Thursday, September 3, 2026, 6:00 p.m. – 8:30 p.m., St. Croix Educational Complex, Kingshill*

Note that Doors open 15 minutes before each meeting begins.

- Board policies and how the public can access them
- The 2026 School Management and Accountability Report
- New developments in educator certification
